I am directed to forward herewith the following proposals and to state that this Government have no objection to accord affiliation to them subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned here under.


1. ✓ Bharatiya Vidya Bhavans Residential School, Tadepalligudem, West Godavari District.
2. K.M.Reddy Memorial Vidya Peethan, Nellore,
3. Thapar Vidya Vihar, Kamalapuram, Warangal District.
4. Golden Bud's Primary School, Eden Garden, Ran Koti, Hyderabad.
5. Hindu Public School, Sanathapur, Hyderabad.

Conditions:

1. The State Government reserves the right to withdraw the above certificate at any time, if the management fails to comply with the instructions of the State Government such as illegal removal of teachers, non-payment of salaries to the teaching and non-teaching staff as per the approved scales etc.
2. Admissions should be made with the bonafide date of birth certificate.
3. All the untrained teachers should be replaced by trained teachers.
4. The Management should collect the tuition fee and special fee etc., as prescribed by Government from time to time.
5. The strength in Classes should be as per Rules in force.
6. The management should follow the State syllabus for classes from I to V.

7. The School should follow the three language formula.
8. The District Educational Officer or his nominee should be invited when the management makes recruitment of candidates of various categories of posts.
9. Staff salaries should be paid as per Government scales of pay.
10. Play facilities should be provided.
11. The management should not collect donations either from students or parents for admissions.
12. The management should implement the Teachers' provident Fund Scheme.
13. No pupil studying in the School now is put to hardship for continuing in the same school.
